


## **COMPANY PROFILE**





ARCH. PH.D. ALESSIA MAGGIO



AMAART Architects is an architecture, engineering and design studio. We work with materials, light, shadows and transparencies and our design is inspired by art and nature. The core competence of the studio is urban mobility, in fact we strongly believe that mobility spaces are at the heart of a transformation in which the protagonist is the public space.

Architect Ph.D. **Alessia Maggio** is the founder of the studio. She graduated in Architecture at La Sapienza University of Rome. In 2010 she obtained a Ph.D. in Architectural Design and Composition and she's also chartered member of Royal Institute of British Architects (RIBA) since 2020.

She graduated in Architecture at the University of Rome, La Sapienza, in 2004. She began her academic training as a teaching assistant from 2005 to 2013, during which time she won the Scholarship for the Doctorate in Architecture and Composition at the University of Rome, La Sapienza, Department of Architecture and Design, DìAP.

Her doctoral thesis addressed the theme of the Non-finito in architecture, L'Opera Aperta: l'architettura aperta alla trasformazione, 2010, under the coordination of Prof. Arch. Valter Bordini. She thus obtained the title of Doctor in Architectural Composition (Theories of Architecture) in 2010.

In the first years of design assistance he worked on the freehand illustrated drawings for the text Ventuno parole per l'Urbanistica, published by Carrocci Editore 2008, within the Urban Planning I Course coordinated by Prof. Claudia Mattogno, University of Civil Engineering and Architecture Rome, La Sapienza, located in San Pietro in Vincoli, Rome, Italy.

In 2015 he won the First Prize for the International Competition of Ideas, Parco del Colle Bellaria a new Landmark Antenna for Salerno. In the same year he continued to participate in international and national competitions, where he won the first prize ex aequo for a layout of a square in Salerno, as part of the Competition, Ombre d'Artista Salerno 2013. Participating in numerous international architecture competitions, including Europan 12 with a proposal for the redevelopment of the Venezia Mestre Station, a project published by the municipality of Venice, and exhibited in Venice as part of the official award ceremony.


She designs and builds her first architectural work, as part of the restyling intervention programs of the Italian Railway Line (FS) such as the Restyling of the Vigna Clara Station located in Rome, year 2015-2016. The work wins the First Prize, with the Global Architecture and Design Award 2018, First Award and the First Prize in the competition Re-thinking The Future, India; winner in the same year of the Award for the Iconic Architecture Award 2018, Munich-Germany. From 2016-2018 she realizes the Restyling projects of the Gemelli-Cesano-La Storta and Valle Aurelia Stations, Rome. As part of the architectural redevelopment of the FL3 section and of the wider project for the redevelopment of the 620 Italian stations called by the Italian Railway Network-RFI, for the enhancement of the territory and the removal of architectural barriers as part of the project.













## Loulouyah Adventure Mountain


Located in the Eastern region of Khorfakkan, with its views of the Soueifa mountain and Loulouyah Beach, Loulouyah Adventure Mountain is the destination for entertainment, sports and adventure activities. The competition Design of Ride Stations involves the conception and design of the ride station that will be built on the mountain.

The stations are distributed across the hill and offer different view-points and vistas, apart from serving the purpose of waiting rooms. The highest point of the Adventure Mountains has been conceptualized as an icon for the Loulouyah Adventure Mountain Project, and the city of Khor Fakkan. Therefore it would be designed as a landmark, that establishes the rich cultural heritage of the town. The stations have been designed in cohesion with the topography of the hill, with the waiting room leading to a long viewing corridor on one side and the ride on the other. The viewing corridor opens up to the Gulf of Oman and Loulouyah beach.

The major material used is wood, which gives a local touch to the design, and the color and texture complement the materiality of the surrounding mountains. The use of lights highlight the stations at night, making them stand out as an identity for the city of Khorfakkan. The other materials in the palette are extensive use of greenery to make the hill stand-out as a natural landmark, followed by the use of natural stone as a backdrop, giving a rugged feeling. Water serves as a distant component since it is used to target the visionary sense of the visitors, through the viewpoints and reflections produced by stainless steel.

Alessia Maggio spoke on 30 April at 17:20 at the National Exhibition Centre Abu Dhabi, UAE. Alessia Maggio's intervention "Open Architecture — Space reflects the project identity" speaks about research and illustrates through various case studies of research what connects architecture to the threshold between inside and outside. This limiting space is understood as an urban space, in relation to the theme of living and infrastructure. In addition we talk about the buildings and the urban areas that define the threshold of the inhabited area and how this slowly dematerializes. Lastly we conclude with the illustration of how architecture can become the spokesperson for new forms and space yet to be discovered.



The two-day program hosted over 250 speakers from across the region and beyond. Discussion about the future of mobility in the Middle East and explore topics from Sustainability, Mobility Innovation and Urban Infrastructure.







## STUDIO



## ■ Valle Aurelia

Restyling of railway station

*Period* 2017 - 2018

- The restyling project of the Valle Aurelia station in Rome is part of the initiative to improve the railway infrastructure of the FS Group.
- The station was originally characterized by two architectural volumes with a strong vertical development, an aspect that has been maintained.
- The design outcome offers the observer the idea of being in front of two distinct buildings, one uphill, the other downhill.
- The choice of identical materials for both offers and maintains a strong sense of unity, a result also achieved thanks to the use of colors and the study of distances and the perception of volumes.

Restyling of railway station



- The first project was designed for the 1990 World Cup but it was never used.
- The restyling project, entrusted in 2016, therefore involved the recovery of the old building in order to create the station, as per the initial project.
- The objective of the project illustrated here follows the desire to try to inaugurate a new era.
- The structure is characterized by a single opening, a bow window, which is identified as a visual door onto the railway tracks from which it is possible to observe the entire conformation of the station, the will that it reflects and its relationship with the urban context.










## Marina di Cerveteri



- The restyling is a unique project, in particular also due to its landscape position, close to the sea and the historic center of Cerveteri.
- A project that transforms a functional urban area into a place of interconnections between people.
- The concept of space is one of absolute lightness but also of an open container. This is represented by the precise layout and composition of the slats, which also work as sun filters.











## Gemelli

Restyling of railway station

*Period* 2017 - 2018

- The project idea is based on the study of the multiple urban/architectural fronts of which the station is composed.
- The train station consists of two buildings which have been designated "A" and "B".
- The first is directly connected to the fast urban artery of Via della Pineta Sacchetti. The relationship with the city of this entrance is essentially expressed through the speed, the movement of the vehicular flow and their relationship with a public space.
- The second instead has the main task of giving a new shape to the public space located in front of this entrance. This phase of the project included the redevelopment of the main front and the square in front, with also lighting of the cycle path.

## Headquarter Azuhr

- The restyling project of the headquarters of Azuhr Holding is located in the industrial area of Limena, Padua.
- In industrial contexts, where buildings are characterized by rational languages, this project contrasts with this concluded and defined scenario.
- The key aim of the project is to weave a new façade that covers and envelops the existing buildings and gives the headquarters a new architectural value, identifying a corporate reality of character and in continuous evolution.
- The second skin wraps the entire perimeter of the existing volumes, creating a façade that simultaneously opens and conceals, revealing the design intentions.




